Dear parents:

We are excited to announce that *Heart of a Child Ministries* will be sharing their *Celebration of Life* presentations with our students on Tuesday, April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

*Heart of a Child Ministries* is an Omaha-based, nationally recognized, archdiocese of Omaha approved, pro-life education ministry that brings *live ultrasounds* into schools with professional ultrasound sonographers, master's level social workers and pregnant volunteers. All students see the miracle of life in the womb, listen to the heartbeat, and hear the truth about God's love for the preborn person and for all of His children through Scripture and Church teaching.

Three age-appropriate presentations will be offered, and parent or grandparent participation is highly encouraged and welcomed. In the K-4<sup>th</sup> grade presentations, kids will sing songs with a team of musicians, address Scripture, delight in "fun fetal facts", and see the live ultrasound on the big screen – hearing the baby's heartbeat and seeing hands and feet wiggle. Grades 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> will have a similar presentation – appropriate to their age level – with an inspiring adoption story included.

Junior High (7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>) will explore Scripture and "fun fetal facts", see a live ultrasound, hear an adoption story, and the story of how the ministry was started--inspired in prayer through the heart of a seven-year-old child. They will also hear from speaker, Sarah Howarth. Sarah was in an abortion clinic ready to have an abortion, but instead courageously walked out, found a supportive maternity home, and chose life. She speaks about how the choice to have her son Jude was the best choice she ever made.
