Health Requirements

Please turn in all paperwork by the first day of school.

Incoming Kindergarten Students:

- Physical within 6 months of the first day of school including a vision screen
- Up-to-date immunization record
- Dental record

Incoming 7th Grade students:

- Physical within 6 months of the first day of school
- Up-to-date immunization record
- Dental record

Transfer Students:

- Physical within 6 months of the first day of school including a vision screen (requirement for <u>OUT OF STATE</u> <u>TRANSFERS ONLY)</u>
- Up-to-date immunization record
- Dental record

All Other Students INCLUDING Preschool and Pre-K:

- Up-to-date immunization record
- Yearly dental record

Any Student Participating in School Organized Sports:

Sports physical within the last year (7th Grade physicals will count toward this requirement for 7th Graders only)

Students with Asthma/Allergy:

- Asthma/allergy action plan and self-administering form if applicable
- All medication must come to school in its original container and be kept in the nurse's office/classroom

Students Requiring Prescription Medication While at School:

- Prescription medication form
- All medication must come to school in its original container and be kept in the nurse's office

Non-prescription Medication Form

- Allows student to receive certain non-prescription medications while at school (can also be completed on PowerSchool under the Forms tab in the Medical section)
- St. Joseph's will provide cough drops, topical ointments, peppermints and eye drops when appropriate to all students unless otherwise indicated by parent/guardian
