**The current DRESS CODE** can be found as part of the Parent Handbook. There is a change in the dress code regarding shorts:

- Navy uniform walking shorts-same style as Dennis Uniform shorts
- Khaki uniform walking shorts only for grades 6th-8th—same style as Dennis Uniform shorts
- May be worn August through October 31, April 1 through May
- No lower than knee length, no shorter than 3 inches above the knee
- Shorts should be neither tight-fitting or baggy and must be worn at the waist.
