Lessons and Carols, Revised

Tomorrow we are looking forward to having a Lessons and Carols service with the students in church before they leave for the Christmas break. As a way of celebrating the deeper meaning of the Advent Season, preparing for the coming of Jesus, this year's them is the "O Antiphons" which are the basis for the familiar hymn "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel." Dating back to the 8th Century, these seven antiphons celebrate the prophesies of the Old Testament preparing for the coming of the Messiah under different titles: Wisdom, Adonai/Leader, Root of Jesse, Key of David, Radiant Dawn, King of the Gentiles and Emmanuel. Due to space restrictions, we will have three different services for the various age groups:

- 12:15 grades K, 1, 2 (note the time change due to a funeral at 11:00)
- 1:00 grades 3, 5, 6
- 2:00 grades 4, 7, 8

Each service will also be recorded and a link sent out to families by Monday for those who would like access. Although most students will not be able to sing this year, we have a special display and parts for many students so they can participate. We hope you can join us!



All "buy now" purchases will be available for pickup at St. Joseph Church on Sunday December 20th. Go to http://bidpal.net/cana early for the best selection.




