BIST Tip:

"I can do something even if it's hard or I don't want to." As one of our BIST Goals for Life, this one hits home with children and adults alike! We all have times that we don't want to do things, but we need to do them anyway. At school, when children are facing challenges, this is a helpful reminder that God gave us the power to choose to do what needs to be done. For children who are hesitant, this is a confidence builder. For children who get easily frustrated, this is a helpful reassurance. For children who get angry, this is a calming reminder. We suggest using this same language at home with your children when circumstances warrant. An effective way to do so is to use a calm voice to remind, then give a little space for the child to think about it. They might be surprised to hear it coming from you, but it will be a great tool to show them that, whether at home or in school, God gives us the tools to make good choices.

Winter Outdoor Recess Policy

It's that time of year! The following is our Outdoor Recess Policy, always subject to teacher discretion. To review other recess guidelines, see the parent handbook on pages 20-

22. Thank you for sending your children properly dressed for cold weather!

Blacktop

- -When the blacktop is ice covered, students will have indoor recess.
- -When the blacktop is snow covered, teachers will use discretion to determine if recess will be outdoors.

Temperature

- -Teachers always have the option to take students outside for brief periods of fresh air.
- -When the temperature, with wind chill, is below 10 degrees, students will have indoor recess.
- -When the temperature, with wind chill, is between 10 and 20 degrees, students will go outside for part of the recess. The time will be determined by playground teacher discretion.
- -When the temperature, with wind chill, is above 20 degrees, students will have outdoor recess.
