A Couple Reminders

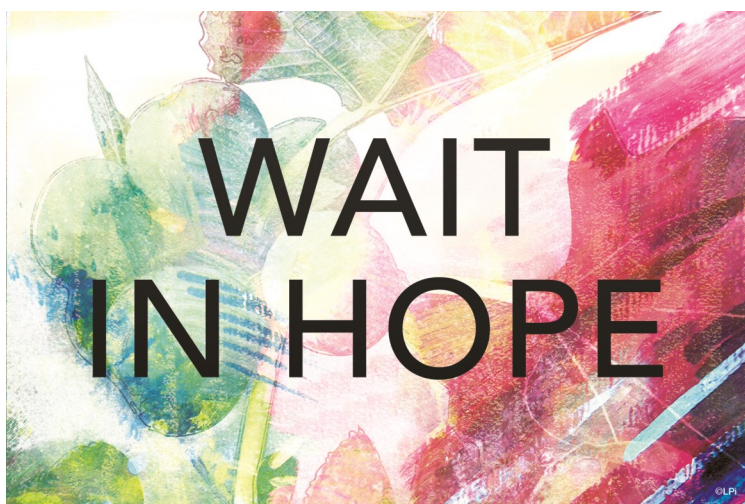
